

## PEMCO's Seven Ways to Prepare for a Natural Disaster:

- 1. Find out the most likely natural hazards in your area and how to prepare for them.
- 2. Learn <u>what's covered</u> by your insurance policy.
- 3. Sign up for early alerts.
  - a. Download an app for real-time weather alerts and help in locating shelters during an emergency.
  - a. Check with your local emergency management office to find out how to receive timely alerts and notifications for your area.
- 4. Learn life-saving skills like CPR and how to use a fire extinguisher.
- 5. Build a "bug-in" or "bug-out" kit in case you need to ride out a storm at home or evacuate quickly.
  - a. Take a look at PEMCO's list of what to put in each type of emergency kit.
  - b. Locate and safeguard important documents, and make sure computer files are backed up.
  - c. Place <u>emergency kits</u> in your home and car.
- 6. Create and practice an evacuation plan for your family and your pets.
- 7. Create a <u>home inventory</u>, which will make it easier if you do need to <u>file a claim</u>. This will also help ensure that you have purchased enough insurance to replace your personal possessions.
